### 2. Qualifications for Application

- 1) Persons who have graduated from university (courses in medicine, dentistry, 6-year courses in pharmacy or veterinary medicine) or who are expected to graduate by March 2024
  - 2) Persons who have completed, or are expected to complete by March 2024 an 18-year academic education outside of Japan (the final courses in medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, or veterinary medicine)
  - 3) Persons who have completed, or are expected to complete by March 2024 an 18-year course (the final courses in medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, or veterinary medicine) in a correspondence course provided by a school in a foreign country by completing the course in Japan
  - 4) Persons who have completed, or are expected to complete by March 2024 an 18-year academic education at foreign university's Japanese school designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology in Japan (the final courses in medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, or veterinary medicine)
  - 5) Persons who have a degree equivalent to a bachelor's degree by completing the course with the period for completion of more than 5 years\*<sup>1)</sup> at a foreign university or a foreign school\*<sup>2)</sup> (the final courses in medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, or veterinary medicine) or are expected to have done so by March 2024
  - 6) Persons who have completed a master's course or a professional graduate course, persons who are eligible to receive a master's degree, or persons who have been enrolled in the doctoral course for 2 years or more, in which there is no distinction between the master and the doctoral courses, obtained 30 credits or more, have received the necessary research instruction and have been recognized as having academic ability equivalent or superior to graduates of medical, dentistry, pharmacy, and veterinary medicine
  - 7) Persons who have graduated from university (expect for courses of medical, dentistry, pharmacy, and veterinary medicine), or after having completed 16-year academic education in a foreign country, persons who have engaged in research at a university or at a research laboratory for more than 2 years, and have been recognized as having academic ability equivalent or superior to graduates of medical, dentistry, pharmacy, and veterinary medicine based on the results of research in our Graduate School
  - 8) Persons who have enrolled in the university (limited to the final courses for medical, dentistry, medicine and veterinary medicine) for more than 4 years, or completed in the an 16-year academic education outside of Japan (limited to the final courses in medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, or veterinary medicine) and are recognized as having earned the credits stipulated by the Graduate School with excellent grades
  - 9) Persons who have been recognized by our Graduate School, based on an individual screening of requirements for admission, as having an academic ability equal to or surpassing that of students who have graduated from a Japanese university, and who will be at least 24 years of age by March 2024
- \*1) Completion of a course of study by completing in Japan correspondence courses offered by a school in a foreign country and completion of a course of study at an educational institution designated in the school education system of a foreign country as specified in the preceding item, including completion of a course of study in Japan by completing correspondence courses offered by a school in that foreign country
- \*2) As evaluated by the foreign government, accreditation organization or specified as equivalent to such educational institutions by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports and Science and Technology of that country

\*Persons who have an ability to pay expenses

\*Persons who will take lectures in Japanese must have ability in Japanese as specified by the Graduate School of Medical Science

◇Requirements for qualifications 9)

Graduates of university, junior college, technical college, Specialized Training College, or other educational institution.

We will conduct the screenings of the qualifications for applicants who intend to apply to our Graduate School in accordance with qualifications 9).

The screening results will be notified to the applicant after the screening is completed.

Once you have passed the screening, please pay the entrance examination fee by the due date.

According to the payment of entrance examination fee, please refer to the **“5-2. Preliminary screening (Screening of the application documents) and Screening fee for the secondary screening (entrance examination fee)”** on page 4.

◇Required Documents:

**5. Application Procedures**

**5-1. Documents to be submitted (\*Required documents mentioned below are for the domestic applicants only. Application forms for applicants from overseas are different, so please contact Fukuoka University Graduate School Office before your application.)**

◇All documents must be written in Japanese unless otherwise specified.

◇The original certificates should be submitted except for those you have obtained permission to make copies. (Copies of the original certificates will not be accepted.) For any documents that require copying, the staff will make copies at the time of receipt at the Fukuoka University Graduate School Office and return the originals.

\* If applicants receive remittances from a resident in Japan (such as your family), please prepare for both a taxation certificate and certificate of residence without my number.

◇The date of issuance or notarization of certificates, transcripts, etc. must be within three months before submission.

◇Documents written in a native language for the applicant must be translated into Japanese or English.

◇Depending on the applicant’s qualifications, the applicant may be asked to submit other documents in addition to application documents.

**Required Documents:**

1) Application Form for Admission to Graduate School of Fukuoka University for International students, Secondary form, and Examination card (see designated form)

The applicant himself/herself must fill out the form.

2) Academic transcript

Academic transcript from the last university you have graduated.

3) Graduation Certificates

Certificate of graduation (completion) or certificate of expected graduation (completion) from the last university you attended.

\*Please refer to page 7.

4) Those who have doctor’s license should submit the copy of it. Those who have clinical practice experience should submit the certificate of clinical practice.

- 5) One-page research plan (see designated form)
  - \*Handwritten in Japanese in applicant's own handwriting (We will not accept the research plan created on a personal computer.)
- 6) Statement of Reasons (see designated form)
  - \*Handwritten in Japanese in applicant's own handwriting (We will not accept the Statement of Reasons created on a personal computer.)
- 7) Certificate of Japanese ability
 

Please submit either one of the following documents 7)-A through 7)-C.

  - 7)-A Certificate of N1 or N2 of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) administered by Japan Educational Exchanges and Services Foundation (JEES) and The Japan Foundation. (Level 1 or Level 2 for students who took the exam before 2009)
  - 7)-B Score report of "Japanese" of Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) administered by Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO)
    - \*The applicant must have a total score of 200 or higher in Listening Comprehension, Listening-Reading Comprehension and Reading Comprehension on any tests conducted over the past two years.
  - 7)-C If the applicant cannot submit either 7)-A or 7)-B mentioned above, please submit the "CERTIFICATE OF JAPANESE LANGUAGE ABILITY" (see designated form).
    - \*Please ask someone who is a Japanese language instructor, a staff at any diplomatic missions abroad, or anyone appropriate to fill in the form.
- 8) Financial Support Plan (see designated form)
- 9) Proof of ability to pay school expenses and living expenses for one year (documents that verify the income listed in "Financial Support Plan")
 

The following documents 9)-A and 9)-B must be submitted by all the applicants. Besides, applicants who meet any of the conditions of 9)-C through 9)-F must also submit documents according to the applicable conditions.

  - 9)-A Deposit balance certificate in the name of the applicant (in JPY or USD)
  - 9)-B Present your actual passbook or other documents that clearly show the history of deposits and withdrawals for the past year
    - \*If you are unable to submit it, please attach a statement of the reasons. (A4 size, any format)
    - \*If you send it by mail, please copy the complete pages of the necessary parts.
  - 9)-C If you have it already, please submit a copy of the "Permission to Engage in Activity other than that Permitted under the Status of Residence Previously Granted"
  - 9)-D Applicants who have received a scholarship permission after April of the admission year must submit a scholarship certificate
  - 9)-E If applicants receive remittances from a foreign country (such as relatives from home country), the applicant must submit a Letter of Financial Support (see designated form) <sup>\*(Note)</sup> handwritten by the remitter himself/herself
  - 9)-F If applicants receive remittances from a resident in Japan (such as your family), the applicant must submit a Letter of Financial Support (see designated form) <sup>\*(Note)</sup> handwritten by the remitter himself/herself
    - \*Please use your officially registered seal.

**\*(Note)**  
If the "Letter of Financial Support" stated in 9)-E and 9)-F is written in the native language, the applicant must attach documents that are translated into Japanese or English.
- 10) Certificate of Residence (without my number)
  - \*Issued by the municipal office with clearly stated the resident card number (or alien registration number), status of residence, and period of stay
- 11) Passport (The Fukuoka University Graduate School Office staff will make copies, so please bring the original.)
  - \*If you send it by mail, please copy the data page where your name, nationality and passport number are written and the photo of the passport holder is attached.
- 12) The applicant who has research experience at universities in Japan must provide documentary evidence
- 13) Address sheet (see designated form)
- 14) The copy of TOEIC score certificate or other language proficiency tests. ("Score certificate" refers to the official certificate of language proficiency tests. The score certificate of the TOEIC (IP) test held at Fukuoka University is also valid.)
  - \*As we use it as a reference, only applicants who have taken such tests can submit it. Please bring the original on the date of the entrance examination.

- \*Please submit the original except for the documents for which “a copy.” is permitted.
- \*If applicants qualified per eligibility 3) and 5) cannot submit any documents mentioned above, please contact the Graduate School in advance before application submission.
- \*Depending on the applicant’s qualifications, the applicant may be asked to submit other documents in addition to application documents.
- \*Only applicants who have doctor’s license should submit document 4) on page 2, and who have taken any language proficiency tests should submit document 14) on page 3.

**5-2. Preliminary screening (Screening of the application documents) and Screening fee for the secondary screening (entrance examination fee)**

- 1) We will conduct the primary screening of the submitted documents, and notify you of the result.
- 2) Once you have passed the preliminary screening, please pay the secondary screening fee by the due date. After the applicant submits the required documents for the first screening, the office will provide the applicant with details on how to pay the screening fee for the second screening.

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**5-3. Notes for application**

- ◆Please confirm the qualifications explained in the “Qualifications for Application” section.
- ◆To submit your application documents, unless there is some particular reason, please bring them to the reception desk in person as there are some points to be checked. (Except for international applicants)
- ◆However, international applicants may submit the application documents through their friends or acquaintances in Japan.
  - 1) Please be especially careful not to leave out any information regarding the examination subject or contact information used for announcement of application results.
  - 2) Incomplete application forms may not be accepted.
  - 3) As a rule, the applicant himself/herself must make inquiries regarding application procedures etc.
  - 4) We will not return second screening fee (entrance examination fee) once paid and any documents (including your research papers) to the applicants.
  - 5) Applicants with disability and chronic illness  
If you need special care during the entrance examination or after entering the university due to a disability, chronic illness, serious health condition etc., please contact the Graduate School Office and your major’s academic advisor from whom you wish to receive guidance as early as possible before your application. Please attach a medical diagnosis form with specific details about your symptoms. If you have a disability certificate, please attach a copy of it.
